Rules of the Lodge and Grounds:

- Guests must be accompanied by a member of the Izaak Walton League, Bush Lake Chapter at all times.
- Please send the deposit and usage fee (separate checks) to the Chapter Caretaker **before** the event.
- All visitors are requested to bring their own garbage bags, utensils, tableware, charcoal and accessories. There are occasionally excess paper plates, wood, charcoal and other disposable items for your use if you run short. Please replenish what you use. Do not bring firewood to the Chapter.
- Toilet facility is located on the south end of caretaker home. Please keep clean, completely close the door (ensure it latches) when exiting the bathroom, and respect the caretaker's privacy.

Before Leaving:

- If heater is required, before leaving ensure that the *furnace and thermostat are turned off*.
- If fireplace (and/or firepit) is used, please ensure that the *fire is completely extinguished*.
- Remove all garbage; clean up spills; sweep floors; return tables and chairs to location you found them; turn off lights; lock doors. Clean up member bathroom if used (adjoining caretaker's cabin).

Hours:

All members and guests should leave the property by 10pm unless a permit for extended hours has been issued by the board of directors. The chapter is a private property owner in a residential neighborhood and every effort should be made to keep noise and traffic to respectful levels.

Beach area:

The beach is unsupervised and all swimming is at your own risk. Parents are asked to closely watch their children and respect the rights of other swimmers and beach users. The beach area may not be reserved.

Dogs:

<u>Dogs must be under control at all times</u>. They should be leashed when other families are present, especially those with children. Dogs are not permitted in the beach area or adjacent swimming area. Dogs may be exercised in the area near the canoe racks or on the south shore area east of the beach. Dog owners are responsible for clean-up and proper disposal of pet waste.

Picnic tables and fire pits:

Tables, fire pits, and grills are on a first come, first served basis. Please be respectful and share with other members, particularly during high demand times. Picnic tables should returned if moved and fires kept in designated fire pit areas only. Do not burn garbage, including cigarette butts, in firepits. All fires must be fully extinguished before members and quests leave the property.

Sound:

The chapter is a private property owner in a residential neighborhood and every effort should be made to keep noise to respectful levels. *Any human-generated sound which can be heard on adjacent properties is too loud.*

No Smoking: Smoking/vaping inside the lodge is not allowed and is prohibited indoors by law.
